

B.E.A.R.S. : category rules and race dates 2011

B.E.A.R.S. by Art Motor is an amateur race series for four stroke motorcycles with up to four cylinders. Frame and engine must have been manufactured in Europe or the USA.

A third party liability insurance is provided by the organizers. A licence or starting permission are not required (except Assen). Further insurance can be signed at the respective event.

The following events, each of these with two races and 1 or two 2 practice days immediately before the event) are scheduled for 2011:

15 th April	Professional Test Day	Eurospeedway Lausitz
16 th /17 th April	Masters of Speed* (2 races)	Eurospeedway Lausitz
14 th /15 th May	Ducati Clubraces (2 races)	TT Circuit Assen
25 th /26 th June	Festival ITALIA (2 races)	Motorsport Arena Oschersleben
24 th /25 th September	BIKEtoberfest (2 races)	Motorsport Arena Oschersleben

At the events marked * the B.E.A.R.S. races may be held together with another category 's races, however with separate classification.

There is no restriction on capacity, weight, tyres or electronic aids. A homologation will not be required.

Four cylinder motorcycles equipped with ABS as a standard option may not weigh in at more than 185 kgs after the race.

Twin cylinder motorcycles may be supercharged.

At every race only the top 4 riders per proper type of motorcycle as well as those riders who have registered before the season as series starters for at least three race events riders may score points. Not more than 4 riders using an identical type of proper type of four cylinder motorcycle may register as series starter.

Slick tyres, tyre warmers and rain tyres are permitted. Series starters (Club Sportbike members) can buy Bridgestone tyres from the official Bridgestone service with a discount of 30 € per set. There is however no obligation to purchase the tyres from the official Bridgestone service.

Noise limit : 104 dBA measured according to the standard DMSB procedure.

If at entry closing date less than 10 riders have entered for the BEARS races at a given event the organizers reserve the right to run the BEARS at this occasion as a special classification within another race category.

The category 's rules and regulations as well as the General *Sportbike Masters* Regulations must be respected by all participants.

At every race points will be given according to the GP mode in the order of the race finish within the rules quoted above.

The rider having obtained the highest number of points after the last race 2011 will be the

B.E.A.R.S. Master 2011.
